



CDC Guidelines for National Association Christian Athletes

1. Athletes and coaches will be required to have their temperature taken 72 hours in advance of the start of the tournament and the morning of departure.
2. Athletes and coaches will be given the CDC questionnaire prior to leaving for the tournament.
3. NACA staff will be given the CDC questionnaire and will be asked to be tested prior to the tournament.
4. NACA staff will take the temperature of each guest upon arrival and again every morning during the week of the tournament.
5. All staff will have their temperature taken each morning.
6. Any guest or staff staying on campus that has an elevated temperature will be isolated in a private room near the nurse station.
7. Hand sanitizing stations will be placed throughout the campus.
8. Food Service will wear face coverings while serving meals. Housekeeping will wear face masks while disinfecting and cleaning guest bathrooms.
9. Athletes and coaches will social distance in the dining hall while in line and tables will only seat six. NACA staff will serve the food and drinks.
10. Equipment for activities will be sanitized between cohort use.
11. All guests will sleep head to toe 6 feet apart in all lodging on campus.
