



## **CDC Guidelines for National Association Christian Athletes**

1. Athletes and coaches will be required to have their temperature taken 72 hours in advance of the start of the tournament and the morning of departure.
2. All coaches will be given the CDC questionnaire with four questions all athletes and coaches must answer before leaving for the NACA.
3. NACA staff will be given the CDC questionnaire as well.
4. Temperatures will be taken daily at the gate of each gym for all athletes, coaches, fans, and NACA staff. Any person with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will be flagged and isolated.
5. Any guest or staff staying on campus that has an elevated temperature will be isolated in a private room near the nurse station.
6. Hand sanitizing stations will be placed throughout the campus. There will be an intense sanitizing on our campus in all bathrooms, our dining hall and gym.
7. Food Service will wear face coverings and serve all meals behind plexi-glass. Our servers in town will do the same. Housekeeping will wear face masks while disinfecting and cleaning guest bathrooms.
8. Athletes and coaches will socially distance in the dining hall while in line and tables will only seat six. NACA staff will serve the food and drinks.
9. All guests will sleep head to toe 6 feet apart in all lodging on campus.
10. Evening rally times will be in the gym or chapel so teams can spread out.
11. Masks are not required here in Rhea County. Each team and each fan will make their own decision on whether to wear a mask or not. We encourage our fans to wear masks.
12. Signs will be posted as we encourage our fans to space on fields as well as gymnasiums.
