

NACA's official statement regarding the Bryan College matter

The National Association of Christian Athletes ("NACA") is a Christian sports ministry to student athletes that has been in existence for 50 years. We seek to transform young lives through the Word of God at our Fort Bluff Camp on Dayton Mountain.

In 2016, NACA was under the strong control and influence of Bryan College leadership. The NACA Chairman of the Board, the President of the NACA and the majority of the NACA Board of Trustees were Bryan College officers, Trustees, or employees. Despite the fiduciary duties owed to NACA, in June of 2016 NACA's \$6 million Fort Bluff Camp property was transferred to Bryan College for \$1.00.

In 2018, a new Board of Trustees of the NACA, which was **not** under the influence of the Bryan College leadership, reiterated a previous request that Bryan College return the assets and liabilities of the Fort Bluff Camp property to NACA because the terms of the 2016 transactions between Bryan College and the NACA were not equitable or in the best interests of NACA. In dispute are rent payments claimed by Bryan College for the Fort Bluff Camp property which property NACA believes rightfully belongs to Fort Bluff Camp. Bryan College responded with a lawsuit against NACA. NACA will defend its interests to the best of its abilities.

We are confident that NACA will continue to operate enjoying God's blessings on camps, retreats and tournaments while seeking truth and justice in this matter. Feel free to contact us with questions.
